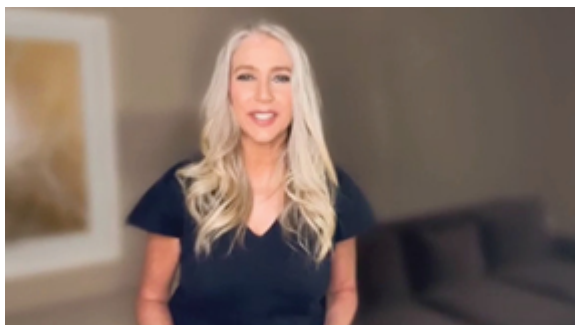
### INTA Continues to Tackle the Ongoing WHOIS Issue


