In honor of Juneteenth, this clinic will focus on supporting Black entrepreneurs and Black-led small- to medium-sized enterprises, as well as not-for-profit, nonprofit, and charitable organizations.

This online program is a single-day event designed like a walk-in legal clinic, where qualified applicants from anywhere in the world can consult with volunteer trademarks professionals on a pro bono basis. Attorney volunteers will be available to address legal questions, explain the trademark registration process, and guide applicants to local services that may further assist them. The one-hour clinic will focus specifically on trademark clearance and prosecution matters.

Relevant Topics Include:

- How to search and register a trademark?
- What are the costs associated with trademark protection?
- What if another party is already using the trademark I want?
- How long does the trademark registration process take?
- What should I do if my trademark application is refused by the Trademark Office?
- How can I renew my existing trademark registration?
